## MATHS

We are partitioning, ordering, adding and subtracting numbers and learning what each digit represents.

The children will continue to improve their mental mathematics strategies through weekly mental maths activities.

We will also be looking at improving times tables skills by following the TT Rock Stars programme. Please use the children's completed times tables tests to practise.

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## Computing

This half-term we will be learning how to improve our programming skills using Logo via the Purple Mash programme.



## PSHE

This term we will be starting to learn simple conversational French.

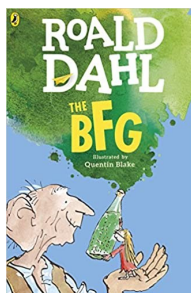


## English
