We will continue to look at multiplication and division. We will also be looking at area and fractions.

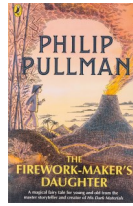
Children will be set a weekly piece of homework on Mathematics and should also practise their Times Tables using TT Rockstars.



English

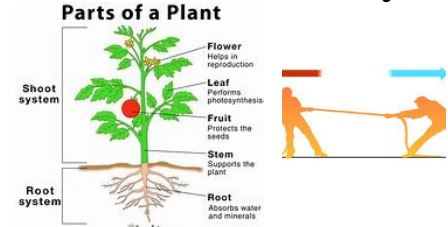
We shall be looking at *The Firework Maker's Daughter* and *Escape from Pompeii*. We will be producing narrative writing.

Please hear your child read every night and practise weekly spellings with them for their spelling test. Work will also be set on Reading Eggs every week.



Science

This half-term we will continue to learn about a variety of science topics including: plants, light and electricity.



Geography

We shall learn about the counties of the UK, a case study of Birmingham and the countries of Europe.



Computing

This half-term we will be looking at spreadsheets using the Purple Mash program.

History

We shall look at the Romans in our history lessons. The children will learn about different aspects of Roman life, including the Roman army. Each class will be visiting Derby Museum to learn more about the Romans:

Pupils in J3 will start learning how to play the violin, whilst EH4 and H3/4 will be using Music Express in their lessons.



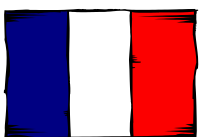
PSHE

ADDITIONAL INFORMATION

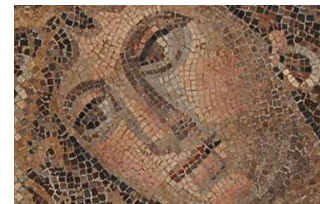
Every week your child has ten spellings to learn. H34 will be tested on their spellings on Monday, EH4 and J3 will be tested on Tuesdays.
