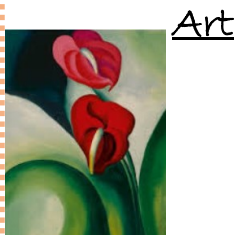


# Year 1/2 Curriculum Letter Spring 1 2024

**Maths** vk1 This half term we will be focusing on place value within 50 and also addition and subtraction.

In T1/2 Year 1 will be focusing on place value within 50 and addition and subtraction. Year 2 will be focusing on addition, subtraction and multiplication and also shape work.

w2 We will be focussing on money this half term and consolidating our number skills that we have learned so far.

**Computing** This half term's unit in Computing is Online safety. We will be learning about how to search safely on Purple Mash.

**Science** We will focus on naming different plants and trees and look at whys in which they can be categorised. We will also look at the parts of plants and also looking at the structures within plants. We will then look at animals, including how they can be classified and the habitats in which they live.

**Geography** In Geography we will continue learning about the UK and will focus our learning on Wales and Northern Ireland. We will also look at weather patterns across the UK.



## **History**

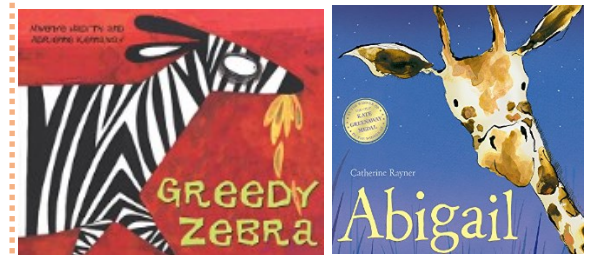
In History the children will be using sources to investigate The Great Fire of London and learn facts about
