

Maths Year 1 will be adding and subtracting numbers within 10, followed by exploring the names of 2-D and 3-D shapes.

Year 2 will be adding and subtracting numbers. They will begin by adding and subtracting two-digit numbers with ones, followed by two-digit numbers with tens, and finally two-digit numbers and two-digit numbers. At the end of this half term, Year 2 will learn the names and properties of 2-D and 3-D shapes.

DT This half term the children will be creating their own healthy snack. They will taste a range of healthy fillings, different types of bread and decide which one they would like to create their healthy snack with. They will learn the skills of cutting, grating, peeling and spreading.

RE Our RE topic will explore the idea of belonging and caring, discussing how people show that they care.

Music The children will work with our specialist Music teacher to learn a range of instruments and songs.

Science In Science this half term the children will be learning to recognise sources of light, sources of sound, categorising electrical appliances and drawing an electrical circuit. We will carry out a range of practical investigations to experiment with light, sound and electricity.

PSHE During this half term we will explore the topic of 'Happy Minds'. The children will discuss their feelings and emotions and take part in 'healthy breathing'.

Geography— We will be learning about the key features of England and Scotland.

English

In English, VK1 will be continuing to follow Grammarsaurus to learn and understand the use of grammar in sentences.

T12 and P2 will explore the story of 'Lost and Found'. They will begin by creating a WANTED poster for the lost penguin in the story, using a range of expanded noun phrases. They will then use the iPads to research penguins and create a written non-chronological report.

History We will find out about the events of the Gunpowder plot. The children will learn who Guy Fawkes was, why he created the Gunpowder plot, and what happened during this time. We will consider the significance of this event.

PE This half term the children will be taking part in a 'GymFit circuit' using a range of gym equipment and parts of their bodies. In Outdoor PE the children will be exploring different ways to run and how to be a champion at running.

Computing We will continue to use the programme 'Purple Mash' to explore and create mazes using the computer.
