This term we will be looking at 3D modelling to create our own cars.

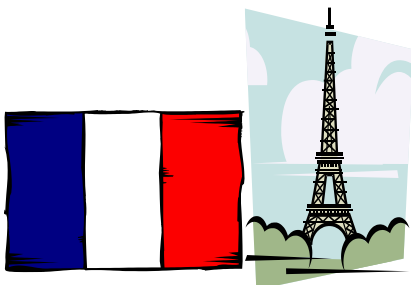
HISTORY

English

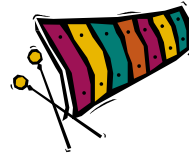

We will study the location of the biomes and features of Alaska. We will look at diversity and human processes.



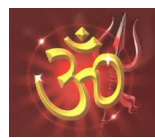
Art

ADDITIONAL INFORMATION

Every week, your child has spellings to learn. Spelling test will be on a Tuesday for B5 and a Wednesday for EB5.

Children should be reading regularly (e.g. 10 minutes, five times weekly with a brief comment in the reading diary each time). The changing of reading books is now the responsibility of each pupil.
