Pupils are taught to pay attention to accurate grammar, punctuation and spelling; applying the spelling patterns and rules set out in the KS3 NC to the key stage 1 and 2 programmes of study for English.

Spelling

I know how to use my knowledge of morphology and etymology to explain spellings.
I know that etymology means the origin of words.
I know that some words need to be learned specifically due to their origin.

Spelling

I know how to distinguish between words that are often confused (e.g. desert/dessert).
I know how to use the first three or four letters of a word to look up spelling and meaning.
I know how to spell words with silent letters (e.g. knight, psalm).

Handwriting

I know how to join all letters but decide which letters are better left unjoined.

Handwriting

I know how to join all 26 letters.
I know how to make handwriting legible by ensuring that downstrokes of letters are parallel and letters are spaced appropriately.

Spelling

I know how to place the apostrophe accurately for plural possession and contraction.
I know how to use the first three letters of a word to check the spelling in a dictionary.
I know how to spell commonly misspelt words, homophones and near-homophones.
I know that a thesaurus shows synonyms and how to use them.

Spelling

I know what a prefix and a suffix is and I know how to add them to words.
I know how to spell further homophones.
I know how to place the apostrophe accurately for singular possession and contraction.
I know how to use the first two letters of a word to check spelling in a dictionary.

Handwriting

I know how to form lower-case letters of a consistent size.
I know how to begin to join some letters.
I know how to write capital letters and digits with a consistent size.
I know what spacing between words is appropriate.

Handwriting

I know how to hold a pencil correctly.
I know how to form lower case letters correctly.
I know the 26 capital letters and what they look like.
I know how to form the digits 0 – 9.

2

Spelling

I know how to spell all of the year 1/2 common exception words.
I know that the suffixes -s and -es create plural nouns.
I know that the prefix un- means not.
I know how to add suffixes to longer words where no spelling change is needed.

Spelling

I know how to spell words containing the 40+ learned phonemes.
I know some spellings of the year 1/2 common exception words.
I know the names of the letters of the alphabet in order.
I know how to use letter names to describe spellings.
