

# Year 1/2 Curriculum Letter Spring 1 2025

## Maths

Year 1: In maths we are learning the place value and how to calculate larger numbers. Later we will be learning how to use measures.

### Year 2:

In maths we are learning about money. Then later this half term we will be focussing on multiplication & division.

## Science

In Science we will continue to embed knowledge of common wild and garden plants as well as naming common trees. We will learn about the structure of plants and name their parts such as flower, roots and stem. We will learn about animals and match them to the habitats in which they live and how baby animals grow into adults.

**English** In English we are reading the story of 'The Snorgh and the Sailor'. We are writing character and setting descriptions using adjectives in expanded noun phrases. Later this half term we will be writing letters linked to the story of 'The Pirates next door'.

## Geography

In Geography we will be learning about seaside towns across the UK and exploring their human and physical features.

Art In Art we are learning about weaving. We will look at some famous weaving artists and then we will have a go at making our own. We will explore a range of materials.

PE In outdoor PE we will be learning the skills required to skip with a rope. In indoor PE we will be trying to get fitter! We will be improving our stamina by doing different fitness circuits like bench steps and sit ups.

## Computing

In computing we are learning to code. We will be using different activities on Purple Mash to code instructions to make things move.

History In History we will be finding out about the Great Fire of London. We will learn about why eye witnesses like Samuel Pepys are so important and key facts such as how the fire started and why it spread so quickly. We will then find out how London was rebuilt and what changed in the way the city was designed.



Music We will continue our lessons with Rock It music. We will be doing some percussion work and following notation.

PSHE In PSHE we will be focussing on relationships and what a positive relationship looks like. We will also be discussing friendships and what makes a good friend and recognise that bullying is not acceptable and we will also highlight the importance of our body language and how this can effect how we portray ourselves.

RE In RE we will be learning about how people use rituals, actions and gestures in their lives. We will find out about how Christians and Muslims pray, about religious buildings and how these are important to believers.
